Maria Safariants. Received an excellent education at the Leningrad State Conservatory of such outstanding musicians as M. Wyman, M. Karandashova, M. Gantvarg and had an internship at B. Gutnikova and professor at the Moscow Conservatory I. Bezrodnoff.

Student years was active concert activity in various areas - solo, ensemble, orchestral - both in Russia and abroad.

For six years, collaborated with Orchestra Internazionale d'Italia as an accompanist and soloist.

Performs as a soloist with orchestras such as Orchestra of the St. Petersburg Philharmonic, the Staatskapelle Orchestra (St. Petersburg), Orchestra of the State Hermitage Museum (St. Petersburg), the Yerevan Philharmonic Orchestra, the Chamber Orchestra of Russia, Youth Chamber Orchestra "Baltika", etc.

Has an extensive violin repertoire, including concerts and chamber works by Vivaldi, Handel, Mozart, Beethoven, Brahms, Sibelius, Tchaikovsky, Glazunov.

Special party concert activity is a series of concerts "Music of the Baroque."

She has participated in international festivals.

Is the creator and participant in one of the major ensembles - "St. Petersburg Trio" (with the famous Russian musician Sergei Uryvaevym - piano and Leonid Shukaeva - cello).

Has numerous recordings on CD and as a soloist in the "St. Petersburg Trio."

Since 1997 he is the artistic director of the largest international music festival "The Palaces of St. Petersburg", as well as president of the festival.

Creative and constructive activity of Mary Safariants repeatedly noted prestigious awards: Honored Artist of Russia (2006); winner of the All-Russian competition and the International Violin Competition in Vienna; nominee "Best Disc of the Year" (USA, 1996); Prize winner of the Tsarskoye Selo; art award winner "Petropolis"; Thanks from plenipotentiary representative of the President of the Russian Federation in the North-West Federal District; Sign of public recognition - Prize "Olympia" (Moscow); Diploma of the Legislative Assembly of St. Petersburg; Gold Medal of the Government of Armenia "For outstanding contribution to world culture"; Medal "Music Bridge St. Petersburg - Boston" for facilitating the development of cultural relations from the mayor of Boston; winner of the contest, established by the State Duma of Russia "Children - the best" for the festival held in his childhood and youth projects.
